

Operates MES vehicles.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES

Persons appointed to this position may be required to work overtime to ensure that projects are completed on time.

Persons appointed to this position must work effectively with limited supervision.

May be required to assist equipment operators and/or operate and maintain crew boats or other small watercraft at specific sites.

Runs errands to pick up parts and supplies for the facility.

Performs other work-related duties as assigned.

SUPERVISORY REQUIREMENTS

This job has no supervisory responsibilities.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

Graduation from a standard high school or GED plus three years of work experience related to the option for which application is made.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Must be able to pass standard physical exam.

Ability to learn the principles and practices applicable to the assigned option and ability to make correct determinations based on observation of those technical procedures and practices.

Must be able to communicate effectively, orally and in writing and the ability to follow oral and written instructions.

Ability to learn to operate personal computers using word processing and spreadsheet software.

Ability to follow instructions under minimal supervision.

Must be able to lift 50 pounds.

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS

Valid driver's license with less than six points under Maryland law.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand and walk. Must use hands, arms, and fingers to handle equipment and document and maintain records. Occasionally required to stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl to service equipment and site structures. May be required to ascend and descend ladders.

May be required to wear protective equipment such as safety harnesses, coveralls, gloves, goggles, respirators, steel toe safety shoes, and hearing protection at specific sites.

Must be able to walk, talk and hear.

Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, night vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to outdoor weather conditions including cold, heat, wind, rain, snow, mud, ice and dust.

Specific sites may require travel to work by boat.

The noise level in the work environment is moderate to loud and could require the use of hearing protection.
