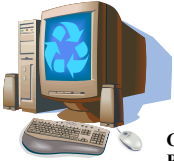

Household Hazardous Waste / Electronics Collection Days are held for all MRRP residents twice per year, one in April and one in November at rotating sites in the four counties.

There are also 45 recycle drop-off locations in the four counties where residents can recycle mixed plastic, mixed metal cans, mixed paper, cardboard and glass (green, brown, clear).
